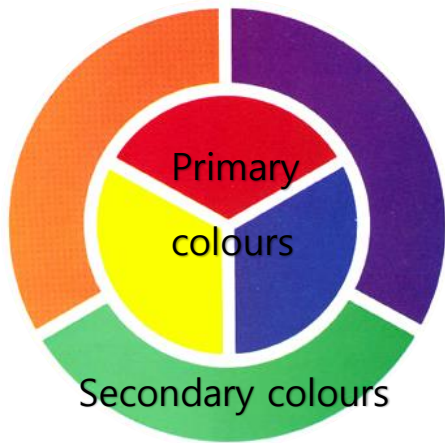


KS1: Key vocabulary

SHADES

base colour
+
black



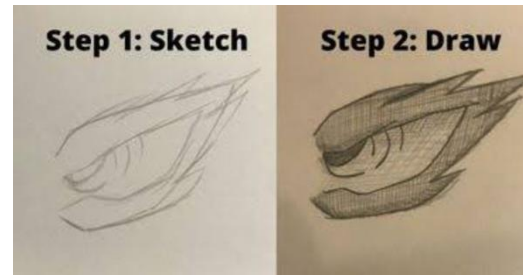
Shade- a mixture with black, which increases darkness.

TINTS

base colour
+
white



Tint- a mixture of a colour with white, which increases lightness.



Sketch: A rough drawing of an object or scene without a lot of detail. Artists use sketches as a preparation for a more detailed painting or drawing.

Drawing: An artwork created from lines or areas of tone created with a drawing instrument such as a graphite pencil, charcoal, coloured pencil, or another dry medium on a piece of paper.




Painting: The art of creating pictures using colours, tones, shapes, lines, and textures is called painting.




Printing: Printing is a way to make many identical copies of texts and images on paper.




Collage: Is made by overlapping pieces of material, such fabric, coloured paper, tissue paper and other types of mixed media.





Sculpture: Art in 3D (three dimensions). Sculptures can be made by carving, modelling or placing materials together. They can be made out of stone, wood, clay or any other material the artist wants to use!
