#### EYFS and National Curriculum

Planning in all subjects is designed to meet and develop the requirements of the EYFS and National Curriculum, ensuring breadth and depth of learning for all children.

## Locational knowledge and place knowledge

EYFS pupils will focus on where they live, the natural environment and find out that people are from different places. In KS1 pupils will name and locate the 7 continents and 5 oceans. To build our knowledge of place we will compare parts of the world. In KS2 pupils will locate countries around the world, focusing on Europe, the Americas and countries of interest to the pupils.

# Human and Physical Geography

EYFS pupils will make observations of the natural environment and know about similarities and differences between places, themselves and others. KS1 will identify seasonal and daily weather patterns in hot and cold parts of the world. We will learn about human and physical features. KS2 will build on this by describing and understanding Physical features currently, and explore the future.

### Geographical Skills and Fieldwork

EYFS pupils will observe and identify key features of where they live and the natural environment. KS1 will use maps, atlases and globes to identify countries and oceans studied. We will use compass directions, aerial photos and directional language. KS2 will build on this by using computer mapping and pupils will also use symbols to build our knowledge of the world.

#### Map Skills

EYFS pupils will have the opportunity to look at simple atlases, draws simple maps and follow directions. KS1 pupils will begin to use maps and atlases. We will follow and draw maps. In KS2 pupils will locate areas on a range of maps. We will use symbols on the maps we have made. KS2 pupils will also draw sketches from high viewpoints and research data on areas using atlases.

Pupils leave Greenfields with a secure understanding of the academic content of the National Curriculum. Our children will have a confident set of skills, knowledge and values which can be used to get ahead in education and life generally. In short they will learn more, remember more, enjoy more and develop more socially and emotionally; enabling them to be ready for their next stage in education and their future lives. We know that by working with our community we can all have a positive impact on their lives. By working together in partnership, the Greenfields family will ensure that every child achieves and succeeds.
