
This was then topped off with a disco! Again, a huge thank you to the small group of parents who volunteered to help out and manned the sweets, the drinks and generally helped. As

As the policy from Central government has evolved, I am introducing two new documents to help us keep track of time being granted for being off school. If you have a child with a medical appointment coming up, you will need to ask the office for the Medical Appointment form, and show us either with the letter or text / email to prove this is happening **BEFORE** the appointment. This will be then be stored to authorize this absence.

If you would like to apply for a holiday during term time, and wish me to consider your circumstances, there is a holiday request form. This must be submitted **BEFORE** the holiday, and again, need proof of booking, flights / travel etc.

Any leave taken which we do not receive prior request for will be UNAUTHORISED, and as such will count towards to 10 sessions in a rolling 10 week period that could lead to a fine.

Any holiday taken without request which lasts for over 10 periods of attendance (5 days) will lead to an automatic fine.

Please do follow this new guidance, and refer to the previous Piota messages sharing the new laws regarding attendance. Thank you.

Children: £10 a ticket


Adults: £12.50
