CONTINUOUS PROVISION IN YEAR 1

- * Play is a **vehicle** for learning
- * In year 1 we have adopted a continuous provision approach to learning. This involves children accessing resources and learning challenges without the need of an adult.
- * This will be available to children alongside adult lessons.
- * The aim is to allow children to explore learning and skills on their own and build on their independence.

IMPORTANCE OF READING WITH YOUR CHILD

- Reading to your child is one of the **most powerful** things you can do
- Just 10 minutes a day can make a huge difference to children's academic outcomes
- Reading books for pleasure helps contribute to the wellbeing of children
- Reading the same text, particularly in R-Y2 supports reading **fluency** and helps develop and build **vocabulary and understanding**.
- Rereading a text gradually increases the number of words children can read 'at a glance'.
- Children will sound like story tellers and will grow in confidence.
- Children in year 1 Should be reading at **least 4 times a week!**



READING AT HOME

- * Library books will also be given out on **Fridays** and changed every Friday.
- * Reading books are given out every **Tuesday and Friday**. Please ensure reading books are returned and signed.
- * An added **online book** will be available on Oxford Owl. The title will be emailed to you **Fridays**.
- * Children need to read at least **4 times a week!**



P.E.

- * P.E days will be on a **Monday and a Wednesday.** Children will continue to come to school in their P.E kits.
- * Please make sure children are wearing the school's P.E kit, which includes a house shirt, black/ dark grey shorts or bottoms.

PHONICS

- * At Greenfields we follow **Essential Letters and sounds** in the teaching of Phonics.
- * Phonics is a way of teaching children how to read and write. It is a lesson we have every day. It teaches children how to decode letters into their respective sounds.
